Professor Gemmy Cheung is Professor, Duke-NUS Medical School, National University of Singapore, and Head of the Medical Retina Department, Singapore National Eye Center. She also heads the Retina Research Group at Singapore Eye Research Institute. Her research is focused on Asian retinal diseases, age-related macular degeneration (AMD), polypoidal choroidal vasculopathy (PCV) and myopic macular degeneration. She is PI of several completed clinical trials in anti-VEGF therapies and 2 large ongoing research programmes funded by the Singapore National Medical Research Council and Biomedical Research Council. Prof Cheung has published >200 peer-reviewed articles and >10 book chapters. She has received prestigious awards including the AAO Secretariat and Achievement awards, APAO Outstanding Service in Prevention of Blindness Award, APAO Nakajima Award, the Macula Society Young Investigator Award, and the APVRS Constable lecturer. She is also examiner of Royal College of Ophthalmologists UK, College of Ophthalmology Singapore, and the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
