Graham Holder became a Hong-Leong Professor at the National University of Singapore in 2017 having been Moorfields' Director of Electrophysiology for 22 years. He has >270 peer-reviewed publications (22000 citations) and >40 book chapters. A co-edited Atlas of Chorioretinal Dystrophies and the revised AAO Basic and Clinical Science Course: Retina and Vitreous were recently published. He has Honorary Professorships of University College London Institute of Ophthalmology and University of Sydney Medical School. He is an Honorary Fellow of the Academy for Healthcare Science and an ARVO Fellow. He was joint recipient of a prestigious Alcon award in 2010 and has received both AAO and APAO Achievement Awards. He was recently named Visionary of the Quarter by the European Vision Research Gateway. He is a past President of the European Association for Vision and Eye Research, a member of the Scientific Advisory Board for the European Society of Ophthalmology, and was ISCEV Director of Education from 2001-2014.
