Dr Susumu Ishida is a leading expert on retinal diseases and is currently a professor and chairperson of ophthalmology at Hokkaido University in Japan. After completing his medical degree in 1990, he undertook his residency in ophthalmology at Keio University. He completed clinical and research fellowships in ophthalmology at Keio University School of Medicine and at Harvard Medical School (Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary), respectively. Dr Ishida's research interests focus on retinal cell biology as well as ocular circulation in various retinal and choroidal disorders. As of January 2022, he is an author on over 350 scientific publications (impact factor: nearly 1250) covering both clinical and basic studies. In 2009, he received the most honorable award from the Japanese Ophthalmological Society (JOS), called the JOS Council Award.
