Professor Wai-Ching Lam is Clinical Professor and Albert Bing-Ching Young Professor in ophthalmology at the University of Hong Kong. He is a world renowned vitreo-retinal surgeon with clinical interests in adult and pediatric retinal diseases. For his clinical and scientific work, he received the Achievement Award from the American Academy of Ophthalmology and Asian Pacific Academy of Ophthalmology, and Fellow and the Senior Honor Award from the American Society of Retinal Specialists.

Also world recognized in medical education, he is a committed medical teacher at undergraduate, post-graduate and professional levels. He has won 16 teaching awards in 18 years from the Faculty of Medicine and the Department of Surgery, and Ophthalmology and Vision Sciences while at the University of Toronto, Canada.

He has published over 100 peer-reviewed articles. He has also authored 7 book chapters, and recently co-edits a new book, "A Quick Guide Pediatric Retina", Springer 2021.
