- 4. Online lectures will be recorded. In case a trainee is on urgent leave, he/she may request for the recording. Please note that the recording will only be given to the trainee subject to the consent of respective course instructor.

Practical Assessment

 In case a pre-registered trainee is absent, he/she will be arranged to attend the next available practical session (if any) provided that a written notice of absence is given to CUHK OMTC Admin Staff by email. Otherwise, the absentee should be responsible for inviting a trainer for a make-up session. CUHK OMTC will only offer venue and equipment for the make-up session.











- 2. Upon your arrival, an assessment form (Appendix II) will be handed to the trainee. The trainee is responsible to hand-in the assessment form to the trainer for fill and sign. Immediate feedback and debriefing from the trainer are encouraged.
- 3. Before leaving the practical, CUHK OMTC Admin Staff will collect from the trainee 1) assessment form filled and signed by trainer and 2) course evaluation form. We encourage the trainee to take a photo or photocopy the filled and signed assessment form for their own record.
- 4. CUHK OMTC Admin Staff will return your assessment form to COHK within 14 days. If trainee did not return the filled and signed assessment form to CUHK OMTC before leaving the practical, he/she will be responsible to communicate with COHK.

In case a trainee was recommended "Need to repeat practical session," a repeat practical session will be arranged. A new assessment form will be issued to the trainee again during the repeat practical session, and the trainee shall hand-in the assessment form to the trainer to fill and sign on site as per points #2 - #4 above.

Appendix I.

<u>COHK Guidelines for Simulated Surgical Training:</u> <u>Laser</u>

- 1. This course should have 3 modules:
 - I. Anterior segment laser
 - II. Posterior segment laser
 - III. Glaucoma laser

The 3 modules may be taught at the same time or separately (in any order).

- 2. All 3 modules should be completed during basic surgical training.
- **3.** It is strongly recommended that trainees should have completed the relevant module(s) before performing the corresponding procedures on patients under supervision.
- 4. The course should consist of two parts, lecture and practical.
- 5. The lecturer(s)/ trainer(s) must be registered trainers of the College of Ophthalmologists of Hong Kong

- 3. Informed consent
- 4. Common complications and principles of their management
- 5. Post-laser management, including medication and follow-up

Practical:

- Each trainee should have at least 30 minutes of supervised practice time per module(90 minutes for 3 modules)
- The overall trainee to trainer ratio should not exceed 3 to 1
- **6.** Training centres should apply for approval of the course at least 1 month before the proposed course date, retrospective application will not be accepted.
- 7. Each approval will be valid for two years, after which the training centre concerned need to apply for approval again.
- **8.** The training centre concerned need to return the assessment forms within 14 days after the course.
